

Technical consulting services are here to help local small-businesses create long-term growth strategies designed to improve the firm's competitiveness. These firms typically represent Seattle's under-served communities—companies that are either minority-owned, women-owned and/or a firm located within an economically distressed community.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Teams of undergraduate students from the UW Foster School of Business are paired with Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) advisors to assist businesses in technological transformation. These teams develop a strategy and implementation plan for integration of new technologies that meet the needs and budget of the firm. Technical consulting projects may include creating a implementation road-map, researching software and applications, and analyzing a firm's financial health for investing in new technology.

This annual intensive consulting program lasts approximately 6 months and begins in February.
